Why do the course?

The course is designed to facilitate the delivery of collaborative and optimal perioperative care to patients presenting with complex, chronic and acute medical conditions requiring surgical intervention by physicians working in the emerging field of perioperative medicine. The course adopts an evidence base and risk-informed approach to the justification of perioperative medical interventions within the modern surgical setting. Additionally, the course aims to develop skills in research and clinical leadership within this emerging medical discipline.

Who is the course aimed at?

This Master of Medicine is recommended for medical practitioners who manage patients in the perioperative period, and those who want to improve practice in this area.

Course entry requirements

1. An Australian Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS), or Doctor of Medicine (MD) degree, or International equivalent recognised by the Medical Board of Australia or deemed equivalent by Faculty.
2. Two years completion of clinical hospital medicine.
3. Meet the minimum Monash English Language Requirement Policy.

Structure

48 credit points of perioperative medicine core units

- POM5101 – Perioperative medicine and cardiorespiratory disease
- POM5102 – Acute perioperative care
- POM5103 – Perioperative medicine and co-existing conditions

Capstone project units

- POM5105 – Contemporary issues in perioperative medicine
- POM5106 – Perioperative medicine capstone project

20–24 hours per week per unit
